Like we said, Professor Felsman is not a nice man and his mind works in mysterious ways! This guide will lead you to the solutions of all the puzzles. If you need this guide, Tou probably didn't survive, so this walkthrough is for your next of kin.

Part 1: find the combination to open the vault.

You have to read the letter word for word, starting with 'Hello' on one side and then Dirk on the other side.

The letter tells you that you have to fold the puzzle in a certain way. The right way is determined by it's element of <u>S</u> <u>U</u> <u>Pr I</u> <u>Se</u>.

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The element Sulfur (S) has the number 16 on the Periodic Table. If you look at the cabinet with the bottles, number 16 says 'First'. Uranium (U) is number 92 and says 'Gold' on the bottle in the cabinet. When you have done that using all the letters from S U Pr I Se: Praseodymium (Pr) = 59, Iodine (I) = 53 and Selenium (Se) = 34, this will give you the correct folding order for the folding puzzle. Gold first, Silver second, then Copper third. Gold is Au TH E


on the Periodic Table, Silver Ag and Copper Cu. Fold the folding puzzle: Au on Au, Ag on Ag and then Cu on Cu as explained in the letter.

The puzzle will read: The code to the vault is 36?5.

To solve the test tube problem with ER on it, you have to use the alphabet wheel on the Chrono Decoder, J=M is the key. Put the J on the alphabet wheel on the Chrono Decoder where it says M. The W on the Chrono Decoder translates into a T. Do this for all the letters. Solution: 'the missing digit is one'.

Part 2: find the correct bottles to make the antidote.

You have to combine the alphabet wheel on the Chrono Decoder with the letters on the wall. You can read on the whiteboard that J is no longer M. Find the little note on the cupboard that says U=A. That's the new code you need. This will give you the sentence 'Place the blue square on the triangle on the clipboard'. The triangle is not a shape but a word you can find in the text. If you place the card with the blue square on the word triangle, the words 'The second bottle is green' will appear. Green is 1 on the color card.

Using the mirror, the sentence on the whiteboard reads 'If you find the early bird you always know the first right answer'. On the logo of the lab, you will see a red bird. The first key of the code is red. Red is 4 on the color card.




If you cross out all the words on the word seeker, it will leave you the letters 'yellow' and the image of the corresponding bottle. <u>Yellow is 5 on the color card</u>.

On the weekly planner you will see 1 instead of 1:00, the same goes for 2, 3 and 4. They all have two signs. 1 has ++, 2 has -+, 3 has +-, 4 has --.

These same signs can be found on the back of the four cards. Put them in this order on the black lines and make a card fan. Look closely at the back of the 4 cards; the letters 'BLUE' will appear within the shape of a bottle. This bottle shape is the fourth bottle on the code card. Blue is 6 on the color card.

Part 3: mix the exact amount of liquids from the bottles.

The four bottle cardsleeves all have a black number. The blue bottle has a black 1, the red a 2, yellow a 3 and green a 4. This is the right order for the code.

The blue and red bottle combined say 'My favorite'. Now pull out the card of the blue bottle as far as the dotted line. You can read 'element' and the blue bottle is filled up to number 1.

Pull out the card from the red bottle until you see SUPrISe. This was written on the note in Part 1 'my favorite element is SUPrISe'.

The red bottle is now filled up to 3.

The yellow bottle has a right hand with lines on it. Take the left hand card from Part 2 and draw the lines on your own hands. Cross all your fingers together like the gloves in the lab. You see the number 4, fill the yellow bottle up to number 4.

Pull out the card from the green bottle until it says 'stop here'. This is written on the back of the green card. <u>The green bottle is now filled to number 1.</u>
